Geelong Train trip Tuesday 16th November

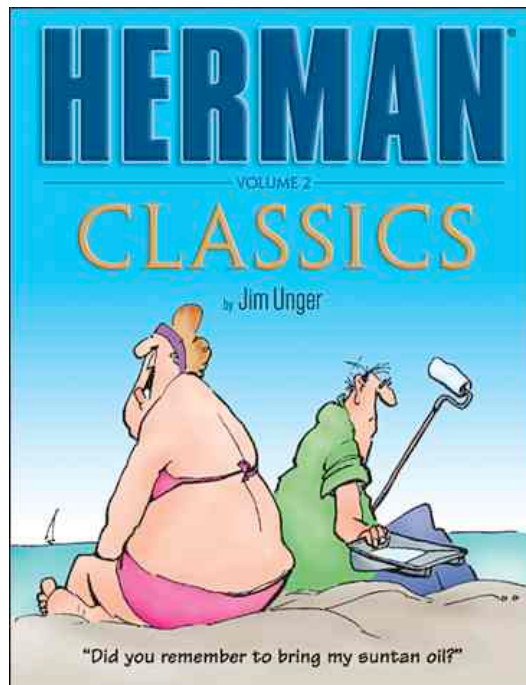
This trip proved to be very successful with the weather proving to be kind and the lunch very enjoyable.

If you would enjoy a pleasant flat walk, with yummy morning tea, then go along to this one.

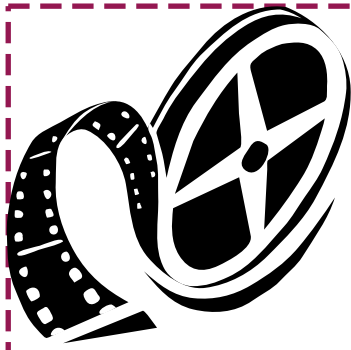
Thursday 16th - This will be our Mooroolbark walk. We meet at the North side of the railway Crossing on
